



Swim-in Zone General Rules and Policies

This is a non-smoking facility!!!

- All participants whether adults or children must have a signed waiver on file. All group or birthday party participants must have a waiver signed by the children's own parent.
- The pool closes 15 minutes before the facility closes.
- A parent or an adult responsible for the children must be present in the facility. For some programs such as swim team practice, class or camp, parents may sign a special release/waiver to permit the swimmers to attend without their parents in attendance.
- An adult must be IN THE WATER with children who are not 52" tall or cannot pass the swim test.
- Swim test: jump into 5 ft.; swim 15 ft.; tread water 1 min.; swim back to starting place.
- A lifeguard must be in the pool area while anyone is in the pool.
- Only wearable flotation devices approved by the U.S. Coast Guard are permitted. No swimmies, floaties, flotation swim suits, swim rings, etc.
- Recreational swim participants may only use Swim-in Zone diving rings, kickboards and noodles. Abuse of Swim-in Zone equipment or endangering others will result in withdrawal.
- No recreational diving of any kind. The pool depth is 3 1/2 ft to 5 ft deep.
- Wear jewelry at your own discretion, as it presents many problems, injury or loss.
- Swim-in Zone is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged valuables, jewelry or articles brought into the facility or onto Swim-in Zone property including the parking lot.
- Bring your own lock for the lockers. Locks must be removed daily. Leave valuables at home.
- We would like to eliminate all fecal accidents. Children who are not reliably potty trained must wear a disposable swim diaper underneath a non-disposable swim diaper or rubber/plastic pants. We sell swim diapers at Swim-in Zone.
- Water is permitted in the pool area, no other food and drink.
- Help keep street dirt off the deck and out of our filters by minimizing street shoes or strollers.
- Remove band-aids (distraction and clog filter), gum (choking hazard) and jewelry.
- No running, pushing, shoving, horseplay, profanity, and any behavior that might disrupt or harm.
- Long hair must be secured in a pony tail, braids or swim cap.
- Glass items are prohibited.
- Appropriate swimming attire- no jeans or cut-offs. T-shirts are discouraged.
- Lifeguard decisions are final. Mistreatment of staff will not be tolerated.
- No one should swim with open sores, contagious skin conditions such as molluscum contagiosum, pink eye or diarrhea. Chicken pox scabs must be completely gone. A doctor's release note may be required with certain skin conditions when returning to the pool.
- Please reserve the ladies and men's locker rooms for the adults if possible. Children 5 and under swimming with a parent may go into the locker rooms with their parents. Children should use the unisex shower area, restrooms and the changing areas around the parent observation room.
- No children ages 6 and up are permitted in the locker room of the opposite sex. Please be considerate of others and use the family changing rooms.
- Swimmers must shower in their bathing suit when using the unisex shower area.
- Good goggles are recommended and sold at Swim-in Zone.
